

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual SJSU Day of Service Frequently Asked Questions

*Q: Is there a limit to team size?*

A: There is no limit on the number of members a team can have, however each person who intends to participate will need to go to [www.sjsu.edu/dayofservice](http://www.sjsu.edu/dayofservice) to register and submit a waiver form.

*Q: I am trying to register for my team but I do not see my team's name on the drop down list, what do I do?*

A: In order to register to participate with your team, the team name needs to be registered first. If you do not see your team's name on the drop down list, please contact your team captain to register the team. If you are the team captain, please follow the steps to register your team's name.

*Q: Are there any restrictions I should be aware of?*

A: Participants must be available starting at 8:00am to 2:00pm on May 8<sup>th</sup>. Registration closes on April 29, 2009 or once we have 1,500 volunteers signed up and unfortunately we are unable to accommodate sign ups on the day of the event, so register early!

*Q: When will I get my project assignment?*

A: Participants will get project assignments as they check-in on the day of the event. We try to accommodate project preferences as best we can but cannot guarantee any requests for a particular project.

*Q: I have class or a meeting so I can only attend a portion of the day, is it possible to work for only a portion of the day?*

A: At this time participants need to be available for the entire service work time which starts at approximately 8:30am and will conclude around 2:00pm. Some project sites require participants to travel by bus (provided) to the project sites and due to liability reasons participants will need to remain at the work site for the entire work time. Upon returning from the work sites employees of the University may partake in the Day of Service BBQ and Entertainment or choose to return to work.

*Q: Can non students participate?*

A: Anyone can participate in SJSU's Day of Service however each person who wishes to participate will need to register at [www.sjsu.edu/dayofservice](http://www.sjsu.edu/dayofservice) prior to the deadline. Also, participants 12 years-old and younger require a parental/legal guardian be present at all times.

*Q: If we have participants who have limited abilities, how can we ensure an appropriate project will be assigned?*
